Minutes of the Meeting:


The Convener presented the letter and the members present discussed the matter in great detail. After a prolonged discussion the committee agreed on the following suggestions;

They also said that in the survey at Patratu valley they had visited settlements which was close to place of dispatch individually and had returned to their starting point in due time there was no plan to leave any of their fellow classmates.


Observations made by the ICC:

- The gravity of the allegations is serious but comprehensive details of the allegations in any form could not be substantiated by Ocishi or her parents.
- The faculty members of the department had not witnessed any misbehaviour of such serious nature amongst Oeishi and the 12 accused students of her class during classes or even field work.
- > The 12 accused students also denied all the allegations raised in their names.
- However members felt from the discussions that Oeishi had never been able to fit in with her classmates, kept her interactions with them to a minimum and even refrained from indulging in group activities
- Oeishi and even her parents had repeatedly stated that she had not received help of any sort during the course of her study in Bidhan Chandra college from her class mates but the members found that 2 of her friends namely Sana Naziba and Swarnadeep Saha has regular connections with her regarding study materials and even class timings.
- Whatsapp chat between Oeishi and Sana Naziba and Swarnadeep Saha regarding class routine and study materials has been documented.

The members were satisfied with the fulfilment and active participation of students in the National Seminar on Gender Sensitization held on 5th Jan, 201 2.
