ADMISSION

All admission to the 1st year students is provisional and subject to the rules and regulation of KaziNazrul University. The Teacher-in-Charge reserves the right to cancel admission or issue transfer certificate toany student if it is found that any misleading information is provided at the time of admission or not in accordance to the guidelines framed for this purpose.

Admission to Honours courses will strictly on the basis of merit.

The academic session of the college is July to June

Documents to be produced at the time of admission:

- 1. Madhyamik/H. S. Certificate or some other relevant document as proof of age.
- 2. Original mark sheet of last board examination passed by the student.
- 3. Three passport size photograph.
- 4. School leaving certificate in original.
- 5. Migration certificate in case of students other than WBCHSE.

N.B.: If a student is unable to submit the Migration Certificate at the time of admission, it must be submitted within one month from the date of admission.

CONCESSION FEES

Students securing 50% (for boys) and 45% (for girls) marks in aggregate in the last examination may apply for the free studentship and half free studentship respectively.

Privilege will be confined to the maximum 10% of the students admitted in respective classes on merit-cum-means basis. Application for the same will be invited by the Teacher-in-Charge soon after the new classes start. Such application must accompany income certificate of the guardian.

COLLEGE RULE

- 1. A student must attend 75% of the lectures delivered in each subject.
- 2. Behaviour which is unlike a student within or outside the college will be severely dealt with.
- 3. Students are expected to attend all college functions and events.
- 4. Appearing in all test/annual examination is compulsory for the students and secure minimum qualifying marks is compulsory for promotion.

The college provides excellent facilities in its effort to promote all round growth ofeach student. The college has ample opportunities & co-curricular activities.

- 1. Extra Curricular Activities: The College inculcates extra-curricular activities along with the regular studies among students and offers opportunities to participate in various activities so that they can groom themselves for the corporate and social life to become a good citizen of the society. The Students' union of the college organizes various programmes so that they can participate in Debate, Seminar, Games, Essay & Story writing competition etc. Music competitions, Educational Tours & Publication of College Magazine are regular feature of the college.
- 2. National Social Service Scheme: NSS (Unit I & Unit II) provides opportunities to the students to participate in various social work viz. Literary drive, Vaccination, Cleaning adjacent area of the college, Health check-up camp, Blood donation camp. The college adopted the scheme run by Central Ministry of Education from the very first day of starting the NSS.
- 3. Besides other facilities college is equipped with computers in departments like Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry etc. Departments of Commerce has a well equipped computer lab with more than 20 computers. The college office is equipped with photocopy machine of reputed brand along with other facilities.
- 4. The college library is fully automated with internet facility and equipped with rich collection of over 33500 books. Through WEBOPAC system students can check the collections of the library from any place by log-in to the college website.
- 5. The college has separate hostel for boys and girls. Boys' hostel has an intake capacity of 30 students. A separate two storied UGC funded Sudipta Banerjee Memorial Hostel for girls' with an intake capacity of 100 students are built to accommodate outstation students of UG and PG courses.
- 6. Endowment Prize: Karabi Basu Memorial award for best students in Commerce stream (Hons.) is introduced from the session 2016-2017.
- 7. Endowment Prize: Sabitri Basu Memorial award for best students in Science (Hons.) and Arts stream (Hons.) is introduced from the session 2016-2017.
- 8. The college has a seminar room with a seating capacity of 75 to organize various events.
- 9. The college has Language Lab. and E-Class rooms to use modern teaching aids to provide better practical knowledge to the students.
- 10. The college in collaboration with DOECC set up a computer training centre which provides certified computer learning to interested students.
- 11. The college has a well equipped air conditioned computer lab in the B.C.A. department with 26 computers.


